Safety Day is Every Day

The Brunei Shell Joint Venture Companies officially marked the Safety Day on 6 May 2015 with a series of engagement and activities for their staff and business partners at their respective locations simultaneously.

Held annually, the global safety day aims to strengthen the safety culture across the company. This year the focus is on process safety, people safety and road safety.

In Brunei Shell Petroleum (BSP) Headquarters in Panaga, the Safety Day was led by Andrew Faulkner, Managing Director of BSP. It started from 0700hrs where all the leaders greeted and reminded staff at all BSP locations and facilities on Safety Day. The launch took place at the BSP HQ where he reiterated that each and every one must take personal responsibility and accountability for BSP's safety performance. At the launch, Dr Hjh Siti Haziah POKSMDSP Haji Abidin, Head of HSSE BSP, echoed the message from the MD and reminded everyone to genuinely care for each other so everyone returns home safely after work. In his opening remarks, he acknowledged the participation of Brunei LNG staff, business partners and stakeholders from Brunei Methanol Company (BMC) and Shell in the Management site visit or "*Management Turun Padang*" held prior to the launching of the event.
