BSP CONDUCTS JOINT PORT SECURITY EXERCISE

Brunei Shell Petroleum Company Sdn Bhd (BSP) conducted a joint exercise, prefixed "Exercise Belangkas 2015" with Government agencies on 9 September 2015 at the BSP Supply, Transport and Logistics (STL) Base in Muara.

Since its first edition held in 2013, the exercise which was conducted based on International Maritime Organization (IMO) standards requirements, will enable both parties to test the Security Plan implementation and communication efficiency between BSP and Government agencies in responding to security incidents within the port facility.

BSP's Emergency Response Coordinator Pg Zamni Pg Hj Tajuddin said that the annual exercise helps to test the integration between BSP emergency response teams with government agencies.

"We are looking at testing our emergency preparedness procedure and another important aspect is the integration between the Emergency Response team from BSP with the External Stakeholders, which are the government agencies, to see how the integration will be managed and handled in real life emergency situation," said Pg Zamni, who was the Exercise Director."

"Another purpose of the exercise is to identify gaps-gaps in the performance of everyone involved, and we need to close all these gaps so that it does not happen in a real incident. We will keep on learning from exercise to exercise, so that we are better prepared during a real incident."

The exercise was jointly conducted by BSP STL Muara Supply Base, Brunei Shell Marketing (BSM) and various Government Agencies such as the Brunei-Muara District Office, the Royal Brunei Police Force, Royal Brunei Armed Forces, Marine Department, Ports Department, Ministry of Health, National Maritime Coordination Centre, and involved involve more than 200 personnel.
