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BSP RASAU 3D SEISMIC SURVEY PROJECT CLOSURES WITH APPRECIATION CEREMONY

Brunei Shell Petroleum Company Sdn Bhd (BSP) held an appreciation ceremony for external stakeholders, to officially close the BSP Rasau 3D Seismic Survey Project on 28 October 2015 at the Cendrawasih Ballroom, Brunei Shell Recreational Club in Seria.

The largest onshore survey in over 20 years officially came to a close with over 45 external agencies in attendance. BSP's Commercial Director, Awg Haji Azhar bin Haji Yahya was present on behalf of the Company to give a speech.

In his speech, he gave his warmest appreciation to the local community for supporting the operations throughout its duration. He stated "Stakeholder engagement sessions were integral to prepare the community for what was coming - A big thank you to everyone who helped host and attended these sessions. You have been the ambassadors of the survey, spreading the information further".

"During our night time operations we visited almost 5000 houses for information distribution, and even though the operations were somewhat intrusive we saw an incredible support from the community for the operations. This would not have been possible without the help from the Belait District Office, the Village Heads, the Royal Brunei Police Force as well as all other government agencies," he further added.

The Rasau 3D Seismic Survey Project was carried out over a 244km² area in the Belait District, including the town of Kuala Belait and adjacent onshore and offshore areas. This modern seismic data, when fully processed, will enable BSP to make a better delineation of the subsurface in its continuous quest to locate more oil and gas. The survey was acquired between October 2014 and April 2015. At the peak of activity, the project involved a 1,000 man-strong workforce, ending in almost 2.5 million man-hours Loss-Time Injury (LTI) free.
