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About SCOT and TGP

Seria Crude Oil Terminal (SCOT) provides collection, storage and export facilities for crude oil. Additionally SCOT also has facilities for water separation, dehydration and treatment. Located in Sungai Bera, SCOT was established in 1972 and began exporting natural oil in 1974 which marks the beginning of Brunei's entry into the international oil market.

Tungku Gas Plant (TGP) began its operation in 1998, marking a significant milestone of the Oil and Gas industry in Brunei Darussalam. TGP is a facility designed to process natural gas from offshore fields. It converts raw natural gas into a cleaner, more usable form, which is then distributed to power stations and industries across the nation.

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
