Brunei Energy Industry Integrity Pact Welcomes 20 Additional Companies

On Tuesday, June 27, 2023, the Brunei Energy Industry Integrity Pact (BEIIP) held a recognition event to welcome 20 additional companies onboard into their network. Established in 2017, the pact is an agreement between energy companies in Brunei to uphold the highest standards of integrity principles and ethics in doing business. The signing ceremony, which was the first event organised face-to-face by BEIIP since the pandemic, saw the participation of over 60 organisations at Tarindak D'Seni. Present as the Guest of Honour was Yang Berhormat Pehin Datu Lailaraja Major General (R) Dato Paduka Seri Haji Awang Halbi bin Haji Mohd Yussof, Minister at the Prime Minister's Office and Minister of Defence II.

Also in attendance were Yang Berhormat Dato Seri Paduka Haji Ahmad bin Pehin Orang Kaya Laila Setia Bakti Di-Raja Dato Laila Utama Haji Awang Isa, Attorney General, Yang Mulia Dato Seri Paduka Awang Mohd Riza Bin Dato Paduka Haji Mohd Yunos, Acting Deputy Minister (Energy) at the Prime Minister's Office and Yang Mulia Pengiran Haji Jamra Weira bin Pengiran Haji Petra, Acting Permanent Secretary (Energy) at the Prime Minister's Office.

In his opening remark, Mr. Kannan Govindasamy, the Chairman of the working committee, emphasised how it was integral to sustain trust in all parties.

Tone from the top is very important and leaders must walk the talk. In an age of corporate mistrust and digitalization, trust itself is not good enough, but we also must verify hence due diligence is very important who we are doing business with."
