

BSP MARKS CHAMPION'S 50TH ANNIVERSARY WITH RELIGIOUS ACTIVITIES

To mark the significant milestone of the 50th Anniversary of Champion, Brunei Shell Petroleum Company Sdn Bhd (BSP) held a Doa Kesyukuran ceremony at the Ash-Shaliheen Mosque on Saturday, March 26, 2022. This kicks off the celebration for the golden jubilee of Champion oilfield's (Champion) first production. The event was graced by Yang Mulia Dato Seri Paduka Awang Haji Matsatejo bin Sokiaw, the Deputy Minister of Energy as the Guest of Honour.

The ceremony first began with a mass Maghrib prayer, followed by a mass Sunat Hajat prayer, the recital of Surah Yaasiin, Tahlil and Doa Arwah. The ceremony concluded with the recital of Doa Kesyukuran, led by Yang Mulia Haji Mohammad Izzat Izzuddin bin Begawan Pehin Khatib Dato Paduka Haji Emran, the Imam of Ash-Shaliheen Mosque, prior to the mass Isyak prayer.
