

ALERT: FAKE EMAILS ON PROCUREMENT OPPORTUNITIES



It has been brought to our attention that fraudulent emails have been sent out claiming procurement opportunities from "Brunei Shell Petroleum".

We would like to confirm that <u>the procurement opportunities offer is fraudulent and is not associated with Brunei Shell Petroleum.</u>

We ask the public's cooperation to stay safe and to exercise utmost caution against fraudulent emails.

We would also like to remind the public to follow official BSP channels for Tender or Expression of Interest (EOI) opportunities. Please note all official emails from BSP will come from BSP's official email domain @bsp-shell.bn. However, please be aware that email domains can be spoofed. Hence, we urge everyone to remain cautious and to take necessary safeguards against unnecessary phishing or fraudulent emails claiming to come from BSP.

If there is a request for sensitive information or suspicious email, it is recommended to cross check and verify with the respective party in BSP or to contact BSP for further confirmation.



STAYING SAFE AGAINST FRAUDULENT ADVERTISEMENT

- Always follow official and verified BSP channels. BSP only updates through its social media accounts (Instagram: @bsp_company and LinkedIn: @Brunei Shell Petroleum Company), official website: bsp.com.bn as well as verified national media outlets. Tender and Expression of Interest (EOI) opportunities are also updated on BSP's official website.
- Do not respond to unsolicited business propositions and/or job offers from people or e-mail addresses you do not know or trust.
- Do not disclose your personal or financial details to anyone you do not know or trust, or on a website you do not trust.
- Be vigilant
 - Question: Healthy scepticism can save your finances
 - Report: Notify BSP (via its official channels) and the local authorities
 - Educate: Only share verified information with your families and friends. Share your knowledge and prevent the spread of scams.
